In view of the latest circular of WBSU (attached hereunder) the students of CBCS with backlogs in Semester I to V Examinations may take admission to Semester-VI in the session 2023-24, immediately through the Student Portal at the college website at <u>www.bkcc.ac.in</u>.

Procedure for payment is given below:

- Log in to the college website at www.bkcc.ac.in
- Click on STUDENTS' LOGIN, "Login to Student Portal (CBCS)" will appear
- Put your Student ID as Candidate User ID (e.g. B.A/21/0001 or B.Sc/21/0001 etc. {Do not forget to put full stop [.] after B})
- Put your date of birth as Password in the given date format
- Click on Login button
- Click on Make Payment button at the right side
- Students of Semester VI will choose their SEC4 subject same as Semester 5, then click on "update and continue" for making online payment.
- After admission, click on **Complete Payment** menu for the receipt and verify your subjects by clicking on **Subject Combination** menu
- After the payment, If you do not get the receipt, and receive payment confirmation from your bank, <u>please wait till next working day 2nd half</u> and further check it through the Students Login Portal by clicking on "Complete Payment" menu there. If the problem still remains, have to contact College Office immediately.

## The portal for admission will remain open <u>till 15.05.2024</u> upto 12 midnight.

UG Semester Examinations, Honours/General (CBCS) 2023-24 of West Bengal State University. Sub. :

#### Respected Madam/Sir.

We hope that this communication finds you well. We are writing on behalf of the University as follows to address a matter of utmost importance that demands our collective attention.

- The University had received representations on almost all the days of the week spanning between 08/04/2024 to 11/04/2024, from a large section of students having backlog in Semester- I to V Examinations held in previous Academic sessions. Their demand was to allow them to appear for the forthcoming Semester-VI Examinations. The students were found in a vandalizing mood and had caused physical damage of University properties.
- As per the WBSU Examinations Regulation clause 15.3 for SIX SEMESTER B.A./B.SC./B.COM. (HONS./GENL.) COURSES Under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) "A student who has not obtained at least 40% in all the courses in theory and practical components of the paper separately, conducted in the different semester examinations shall be promoted to the next semester with previous uncleared backlog courses. However, the candidate must clear all his backlog courses before he is promoted to the final 6<sup>th</sup> semester. In other word, a student cannot be promoted to the 6<sup>th</sup> semester if he has not cleared all his previous courses".

The above matter was placed before the Academic Committee (Working) of the West Bengal State University under chairmanship of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor in it's meeting held on 12/04/2024.

The following resolutions were adopted unanimously on an emergent basis considering the present scenario, academic interest of large section of students and also to thwart the ongoing student unrest.

- (a) As appealed by the students, those who had appeared but having backlog in their previous Semester-I to V Examinations, shall be allowed to appear for the forthcoming UG Semester-VI Examinations-2024. However, such students must have to pass the other uncleared backlogs/courses within the stipulated time period of maximum Five (05) years from the year of admission in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester.
- (b) This is being implemented as a special case for this academic session i.e. 2023-24 only and the same should not be cited as precedence in future.

In connection with the above and as we strive to maintain a conducive and respectful environment within the University, we would reiterate and emphasize on the following points for your kind perusal and taking necessary action, as deem fit.

- That some of the students may not be fully aware of the proper channels for submitting their appeal/grievances. In light of this, we kindly request your assistance in ensuring that all students are informed that they should approach with their written appeals duly forwarded by the college authority only.
- Furthermore, it is imperative to emphasize the significance of maintaining decorum and respect for University property and atmosphere. Acts of vandalism or destruction of property not only undermine the integrity of our institution but also disrupt the learning environment for all members of our community.
- Therefore, we urge you to disseminate this message to all the students under your jurisdiction through appropriate channels, such as college notices, e-mails, or student assembly. Additionally, please reiterate the University's commitment to upholding standards of behavior and discipline, emphasizing the consequences of any misconduct.
- By working together to uphold these principles, we can ensure a harmonious and productive atmosphere conducive to academic excellence.
