The 36th Annual Conference of Paschim Banga Itihas Samsad was held at Brahmananda Keshab Chandra College in collaboration with the Department of History of the college from 24th January to 26th January 2020. 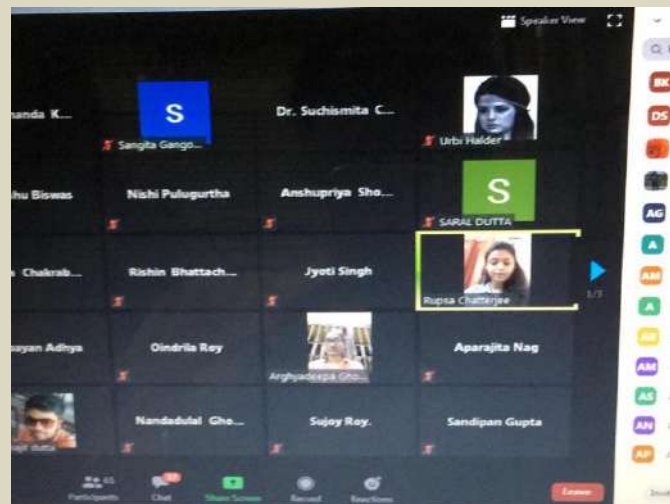
ASSUMPTIVE CHANGES ON ESTUARINE FISH ASSEMBLAGE

- ❖ Variation in fish assemblage structure with higher percentage abundance of some species and marked reduction in relative abundance of some species may be expected.
- ❖ Increase in availability of species which prefers rock, gravel or sandy bottom such as *Glossogobius aureus* and *Ctenoglossus lingua* or of pelagic water like *Harpadon nehereus*, *Setipinna setipinna*, *Liza parsia*, *Tenualosa ilisha*, *Coilia ramarrani* etc can be observed. These species can utilize the benefit of the changed habitat with high production (due to enhanced nutrient load) and can tolerate low dissolved oxygen condition (Greenwood et al. 2006, Mukherjee et al. 2012).
- ❖ Rise in salinity may result noticeable decrease in species like *Gudusia chepra* which mostly prefers freshwater (Mukherjee et al. 2012).
