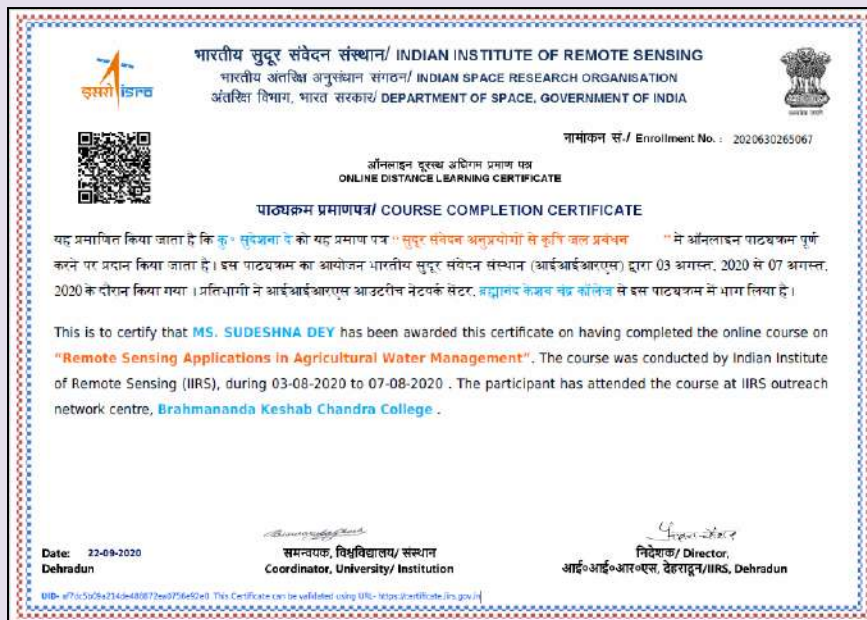
The first issue of the departmental newsletter of the department of Industrial Fish and Fisheries “Splash and Shoal” was published on 1st July, 2020.

A short cultural programme was organized by the students of the Department of Physics on 5th September, 2020 on the occasion of Teachers' Day.

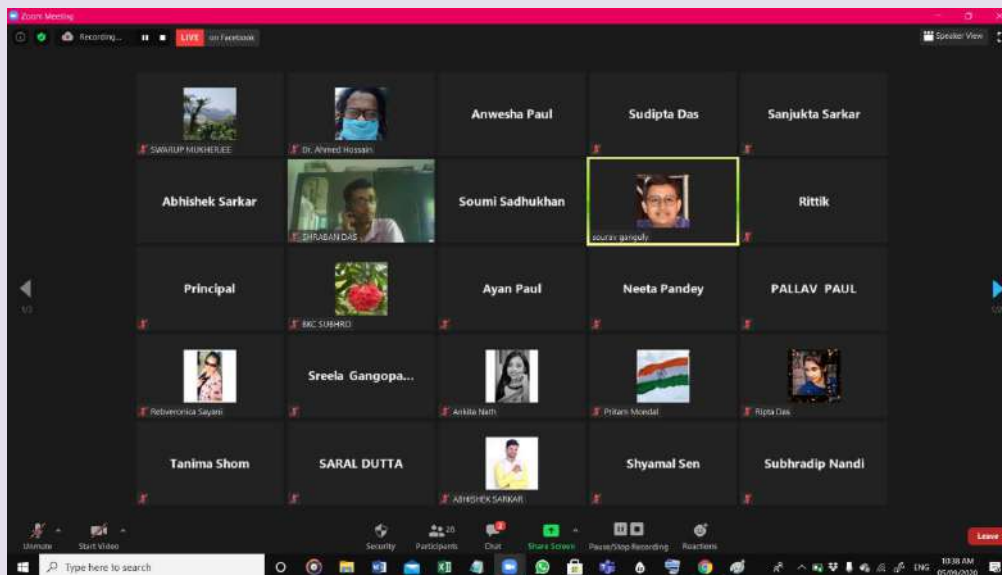

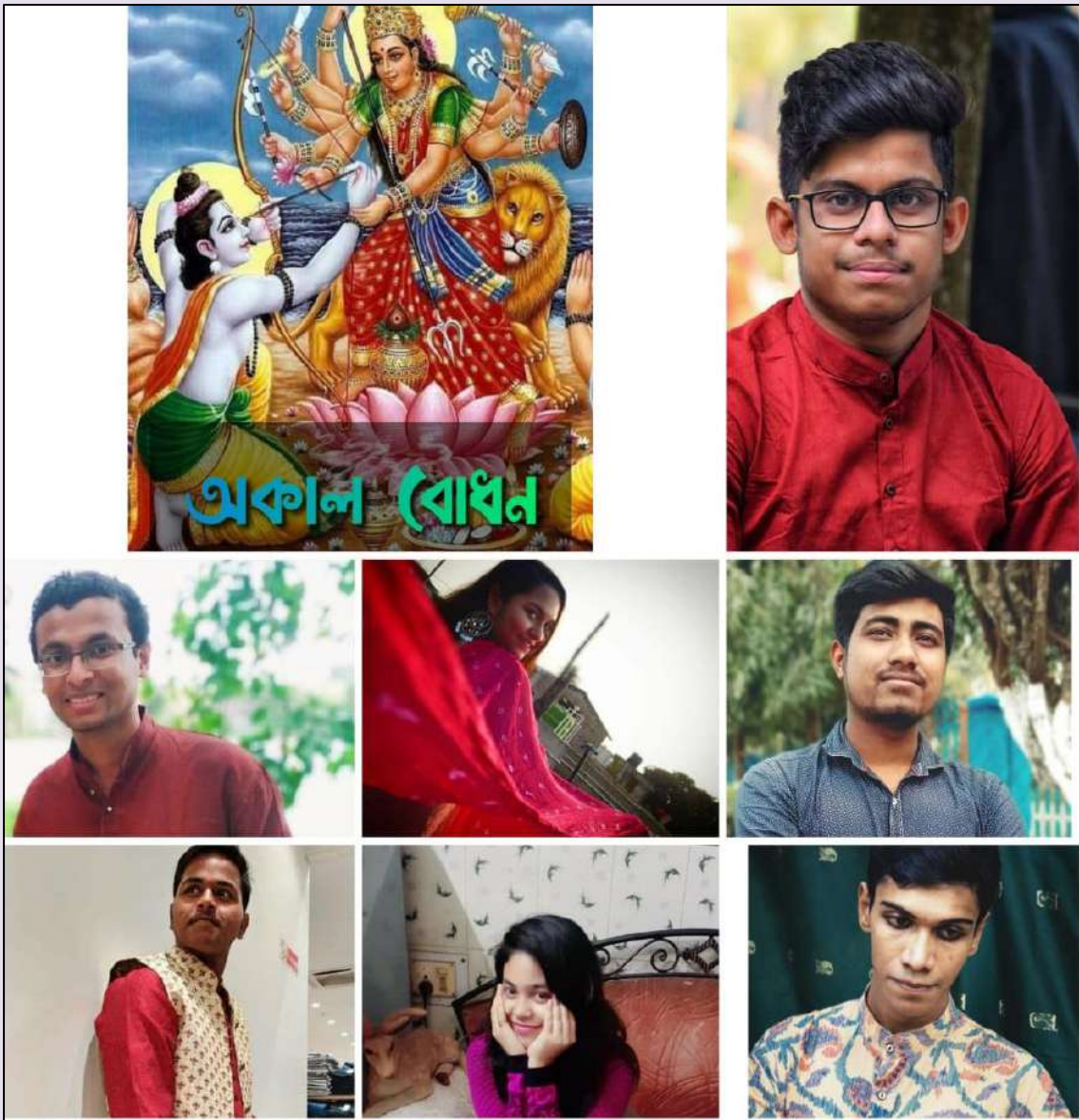

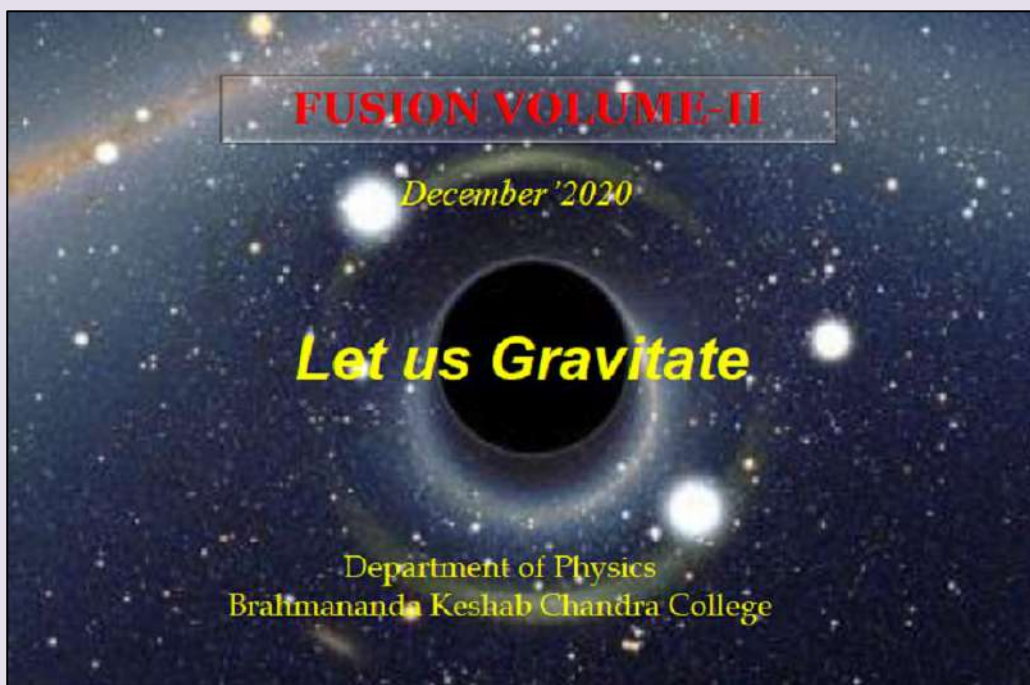
DECEMBER
